

BOARD MEETING
January 1, 1877
Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this Monday evening the 1st day January 1877.

Present Mayor Clarke, Aldermen Stevens, Smither, Thurman, Miller & White and Marshal Ferguson.

The minutes of the two last meetings were read, approved and signed.

On motion it was ordered that the Marshal be instructed to notify the owners of the Steamer Sam Vail to remove the same from the wharf so as not to obstruct other boats from landing.

On motion the Recorder was appointed reference committee to settle with the County Court Clerk the state tax due him.

On motion an account in favor of G. B. Miller for \$7.50 was allowed.

On motion the following accounts were allowed for extra police to Geo. Simpson \$3.00 to Frank Ferguson \$1.50 to Fope Fields \$3.00 to Mr. Childress \$1.50.

On motion an account in favor of G. W. Lavender for jail fees account for \$8.35 was allowed.

On motion it was ordered that the Mayor, Recorder & Treasurer and Aldermen be allowed the same salaries as the previous year, to wit: The Mayor \$100.00, Recorder & Treasurer \$150.00 and Aldermen \$25.00 each for the year 1876. On motion it was ordered that Marshal Ferguson be allowed \$300.00 for his services as Marshal and Street Commissioner for the year 1876.

On motion it was ordered that G. B. Miller be allowed \$25.00 as assistant street commissioner.

On motion Board adjourned.
