The Board of Aldermen met at the Court House in Dyersburg this evening at candle

light.

Present: Mayor DeBerry, Aldermen Child, Roberts, Pinner and Sampson and

Marshal Nichols.

On a motion of Alderman Roberts the following amendment to the Ordinance

passed by this Board on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1871 was unanimously adopted.

"The Bonds issued to the Mississippi River Railway, if the tax be voted, shall have

printed on the face of every bond "This Bond is issued on condition that the Mississippi

River Railway is to be located and built to Dyersburg and have a Depot of said road located

within half a mile of the present Court House in Dyersburg."

Ordered that the Board adjourn.
