On motion the report of the committee who were appointed to report on the

propriety and the expediency of purchasing a fire engine, informed, unable to the purchase

was received by the Board and said committee discharged.

On motion a committee, to wit: Aldermen Miller and Pinner were appointed to

report on the propriety of purchasing a "Fire Extinguisher".

On motion the report of the committee appointed on the plank walk to the Female

Academy, reporting that they had employed Turner and Adams to build it for \$105.88 and

that it had been completed and accepted, was by the Board received.

On motion the sum of \$105.88 was allowed to Turner & Adams for building the

plank walk to the Female Academy.

On motion Capt. G.B. Miller was allowed \$25.00 to repay the expenses he incurred

in his trip to Memphis in relation to the Railroad.

On motion it was ordained that E.G. Sugg be appointed to make a permanent

survey of the Original Town of Dyersburg and drive stakes at all the corners of all the lots.

On motion it was ordained that the regular meetings of this Board shall be held on

the first Thursday night in every month hereafter.

On motion the Board adjourned.
