

**BOARD MEETING**  
**Thursday, October 3, 1872**  
**Court House**

The Board of Aldermen met at the Court House in Dyersburg at early candle light.  
**Present: Mayor Clark, Aldermen Deberry, McAllister, Pinner, Roberts and Sampson and Marshal Nichols.**

On motion a committee to wit: Aldermen Roberts and Pinner were appointed to superintend repairs on the street and draw on the Treasurer for money.

On the written Petition of all the property holders west of Church Street, it is by unanimous vote ordered that Aldermen McAllister, Miller and Deberry lay off to the adjoining lots west of that street fifteen feet off the west side of said street reducing its width from 80 feet to 65 feet, in exchange for fifteen feet off the west side of the western ties of lots in the original Town to make an alley and that they report their action to this Board.

On motion it was unanimously ordered that Marshal Nichols employ four extra policemen during the coming fair at the expense of this Board.

On motion the Board adjourned.
