BOARD MEETING Friday, December 17, 1872 Court House

The Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg met at the Court House at candle light. Present: Mayor Clark, Aldermen Deberry, Miller, McAllister, Pinner, Roberts and Sampson.

The minutes of the last meeting of the Board was read approved and signed.

On motion this Board agrees to pay the expense Mrs. Whitten's removing her buildings in Clark Street.

On motion Mayor Clark and Ald. Pinner were appointed to sell the "Fire Extinguisher".

On motion Aldermen Pinner and Roberts were appointed to superintend the repairing of Church Street in front of the C. P. Church and draw on the Treasurer for the money to pay for it.

On motion it was ordered that Aldermen Pinner, Roberts and Sampson examine and report on propriety of widening High Street and the street each of it to forty feet each.

On motion the Board agreed by vote to pay to T. C. Buchanan and F. G. Sampson the sum of \$27.50 to aid in paying for the plank walk to the cemetery.

On motion J. C. Pinner was allowed \$3.50 for his attention to work on the streets.

On motion a committee to wit: Aldermen Deberry and Pinner were appointed to settle with the Marshal and Recorder and Treasurer for the year 1872 and make report.

On motion the Board adjourned.
