BOARD MEETING January 7, 1873 Court House

The Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg, Tennessee met at the Court House at 9 o'clock a.m. Present: Mayor Clark, Aldermen Deberry, McAllister, Pinner, Roberts and Sampson.

The minutes of the last meeting of the Board were read, approved and signed.

On motion the account of John N. Nichols for money paid for hauling, candles, printers' fees and \$15.00 was allowed by unanimous vote.

On motion the account of McAllister and Leah for tags for dog collars \$2.60 was allowed.

On motion the account of John E. Roberts for money paid hands for work on the streets of \$3.00 was allowed and ordered to be paid.

On motion the account of Stevens Brothers for lumber furnished since May 2, 1872 of \$28.31 was allowed by unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion Marshal John M. Nichols was allowed a salary of \$200.00 for his services in the year 1872, Charles P. Clark, Mayor a salary of \$100.00 for his services and F.G. Sampson, Recorder and Treasurer a salary of \$100.00 for his services in the year 1872 by unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion Aldermen W.E. Deberry, G.D. McAllister, J.C. Pinner, G. B. Miller and J.E. Roberts were allowed \$25.00 each for their services in 1872 by unanimous vote of the Board.

On motion the account of \_\_\_\_\_ W. Neal for \$20.00 of Thomas & Glover for \$20.00 for advertising the Railroad Proclamation last June were allowed.

On motion the Board adjourned.
