## BOARD MEETING March 20, 1873

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg met this  $20^{\rm th}$  of March, 1873 pursuant to adjournment.

Present Mayor Clark, Aldermen Pinner, Coker, McAllister, DeBerry and Doye and Marshal Nichols.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion Ret Burke was allowed six dollars for hauling, on the streets, to date all the Aldermen voting for the allowance.

F. G. Sampson, Alderman elect, having been duly sworn by H. F. Ferguson, a Justice of the Peace for Dyer County, appeared and took this Seal as Alderman aforesaid.

On motion one dollar and fifty cents was allowed to James White for repairing the sidewalk on the academy street, all the Aldermen voting for it.

The committee, on Ordinances and By-Laws, made a report which was discussed and re-committed to Aldermen Sampson, Pinner and Doyle with instructions to report on Monday night next.

On motion the Board adjourned until next Monday night the 24th instant.
