**BOARD MEETING** October 13, 1873

**Court House**

morning October 13, 1873 at the Court House on call of the Mayor.

Present Mayor Pinner, Aldermen DeBerry, McAllister, Sampson and Doyle and

Marshall Nichols.

The Marshal announced to the Board that urgent business would call him away

from town for several days.

Thereupon in view of the fact that the Great International Circus will probably be

here tomorrow and there will be a great concourse of people assembled here on that

occasion - and in view of the fact that Marchal Nichols will be absent - It is therefore

ordererd by the Board that John M. Pierce be and he is hereby appointed Marshal

assuming the absence of the Marshal John M. Nichols - and the following special

policemen are hereby appointed to assist him in keeping order within said Town assuming

the absence of said Nichols, to wit: John T. Fields, Jr., James Armstrong, Eor Talley, Jo F.

Roberts, M. H. Nichols, B.B. Watkins and M. T. Brackin – and it is further ordered that

they have and are hereby clothed with all the powers and authority of Marshal and

policemen aforesaid.

Thereupon the said J. M. Pierce was duly sworn by the Mayor - and he directed to

swear the policemen herein appointed.

Thereupon the Board adjourned.
