House on this 1st Thursday night in November A.D. 1873.

and signed.

On motion of Alderman McAllister the Committee heretofore appointed to locate

the streets in Hales Addition, were discharged - Mayor Pinner and Alderman Doyle voting

no.

On motion Aldermen Sampson, Sugg and DeBerry were appointed a committee to

compromise if they can and locate the streets of Hales Addition – so as to avoid litigation.

On motion the sum of Seven Dollars and 50 cents was allowed and ordered to be

paid to James Fields for service as policeman during the fair week - all the Aldermen

present voting for it.

On motion the sum of Seven Dollars and 50 cents was allowed and ordered to be

paid to L. S. Cox for services as policeman during the fair week – all the Aldermen present

voting for it.

Ordered that the Marshal be instructed to buy a dump cart for Corporation uses

and that he procure it at the lowest price he can.
