

**BOARD MEETING**  
**April 2, 1874**  
**Court House**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg met in regular meeting this 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday evening April 2, 1874 at Court House.

Present Mayor Neal, Aldermen Wilson, Sampson, Roberts, Thurman & White.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion it was ordered that N. H. Gilliats' Corporation & Rail Road Tax for 1873 be reduced to Forty five 00/100 Dollars and all over that amount which he has paid be refunded to him, the Marshall is hereby instructed to make the settlement.

The committee on assestment of Taxes for 1874 asked for further time and was granted until Thursday evening next to make their report.

On motion the Marshall's report in regard to building culvert in McGaughy Street was received and the Marshall excused from further proceedings in the matter at present.

On motion an account presented by Marshall Nichols for work done in Corporation was allowed and ordered to be paid, amount of sum Fifteen 05/100 Dollars (\$15.05).

On motion it was ordered that the sum of One 50/100 Dollars (1.50) be refunded to Mayor Neal for amount paid by him on account of a pauper.

An account Twenty Seven 60/100 Dollars (\$27.60) for jail fees was presented by T. H. Kelly and was referred to committee on accounts.

The above account was allowed and ordered to be paid.

On motion it was ordered that T. H. Kelly be paid his jail fees for all prisoners sent to jail by the Mayor on the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month commencing 1<sup>st</sup> May, 1874.

On motion the Marshall is instructed and so ordered to collect from all securities on fines in ten days after they are assessed.

On motion a committee of three were appointed to confer with the cemetery commissioners in regard to cemetery. Committee appointed by the Mayor was Aldermen Sampson, Roberts and White.

On motion it was ordered that the parties notified to lay pavement on south side square shall have until next Thursday to complete the work.

On motion Board adjourned.
