

BOARD MEETING
August 7, 1874
Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House on this Friday evening August 7, 1874.

Present Mayor Neal, Aldermen Deberry, Thurman, Sugg, Sampson & White and John M. Nichols, Marshall.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion it was ordered that a committee of two be appointed to confer and act with a committee appointed by the County Court in reference to the establishing of a work house in this Town to be under the control of the County and Town Authority, committee appointed are Aldermen E. G. Sugg and Capt. J. Skeffington.

On motion of F. G. Sampson it was ordered that Capt. J. Skeffington be paid the sum of Twenty Five 00/100 dollars (\$25.00) for services rendered in defending suits by Webb & Child and I. F. Child against Corporation.

On motion it was ordered that a committee of two be appointed to confer with the property owners interested in regard to the opening of a street in front of lots owned by Mr. Still and others. Committee are Aldermen Sugg and Deberry and are to report at next meeting.

On motion it was requested that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen advise with the citizens in regard to the best means of protecting themselves against fire by having fire ladders prepared.

On motion Board adjourned.
