BOARD MEETING November 5, 1874 Court Hose

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this Thursday evening, November 5, 1874.

Present Mayor Neal, Aldermen Deberry, Wilson, Sugg, Sampson, Thurman & White and Marshall McClerkin.

The minutes of last meeting was read, approved and signed.

On motion an account in favor of Jno. W. Harten for \$32.78 was allowed (his account having been reduced from \$45.60 to less amt. by the finance committee). Also, one for \$4.00 for carrying pauper to the country an account in favor of Deberry & Baker for \$5.25 it being for nails, candles etc. was allowed.

On motion a clause was ordered to be inserted in our Town Ordinance that no wagon or team shall be allowed to stand on the street crossing.

On motion of Alderman Sampson the Marshall was ordered to request the owners of lots in cemetery, in connection with the cemetery commissioners, to meet this Board at our next regular meeting for the purpose of devising ways and means of improving the cemetery grounds.

On motion an account presented by Jno. M. Pierce was laid over to our next meeting.

On motion Mr. Ford was allowed \$20.00 for boarding pauper one month.

On motion of Alderman Deberry the Marshall was ordered to proceed to collect all unpaid taxes at once.

On motion Board adjourned.
