

BOARD MEETING
January 6, 1875
Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met at Court House this Wednesday evening January 6, 1875 pursuant to adjournment.

Present Mayor Neal, Aldermen Wilson, Deberry, Sampson, Sugg, Thurman & White and Marshall McClerkin.

The Mayor explained that the meeting was for the purpose of receiving the report of finance committee on settlements made with the Recorder and Marshall.

The report of such committee was then presented and read when –

On motion the report was ordered to be received, spread on the minutes and committee discharge.

On motion the same committee was appointed to make a full report at the next meeting of all uncollected taxes, fines due for Corporation and Rail Road purposes.

The following accounts was then allowed:

One in favor of W. H. Nichols for \$5.00 for police services;

One in favor of Jno. G. Seat for \$1.50 wire for culvert;

One in favor of Watson & Son for \$1.90 for harness;

One in favor of E. C. Pate for \$5.00 for hire of mule;

One in favor of L. C. McClerkin for \$16.75 money for Corporation;

One in favor of Neal & ___ for \$5.00 for printing.

On motion of Alderman Sugg it was ordered that the Mayor and Aldermen each be allowed one 00/100 Dollar for each nights attendance on the meetings of this Board.

On motion Board adjourned to meet again tomorrow evening at 6 ½ o'clock p.m.
