

**BOARD MEETING**  
**May 4, 1875**  
**Court House**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this Tuesday evening the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1875.

Present Mayor Sugg, Aldermen Pinner, Deberry, Smither & White and Marshall Fowlkes.

The minutes of the last meeting was read, approved and signed.

On motion it was ordered that the proposition from the citizens to incorporate the cemetery in a Stock Company be and is hereby rejected.

On motion an account in favor of W. B. Tipton for \$6.00 was reduced to \$4.00 and so allowed one in favor B. S. Thomas for \$12.50 was reduced to \$8.50 and so allowed.

The Mayor appointed Alderman Smither to account with Alderman Pinner as committee on finance.

On motion the Marshall was appointed fire warden and all parties who refuse or neglect to make their stove pipes, flues and chimneys safe against the accident of fire, after being notified by the Marshall to that affect, are to be arrested by him and brought before the Mayor to be fined at his discretion.

On motion it was ordered that the Mayor be allowed to draw on the Treasurer for Fifty 00/100 Dollars (\$50.00) for street purposes.

On motion Board adjourned.
