BOARD MEETING June 1, 1875 Court House

The minutes of the last meeting was read, approved and signed.

The following accounts was then presented and allowed and ordered to be paid:

One in favor of Deberry & Baker for \$41.90

One in favor of May & Bros. for \$2.00

One in favor of Sugg & co. for \$70.81

One in favor of R. E. Summers for hauling four load brick bats was on motion reduced from \$3.00 to \$2.00 and ordered to be paid.

An account in favor of J.E. Roberts & Son was presented and on motion was ordered to be returned to them with instructions to collect the amount from the party who made the account if not so collected, will be reconsidered at our next regular meeting.

On motion the Marshall was ordered to notify Memphis, Parr Nolen Co. to repair street in front of the new building and give them until next Saturday to do the work.

On motion of Alderman Pinner it was ordained that all parties becoming security for fines imposed by the Mayor shall be allowed ten days to pay said fines, unless paid in that time, the Marshall is hereby ordered to take legal steps for these collections.

On motion it was ordered that the Mayor call the Board together before our next regular meeting for the purpose of locating Latta Street.

On motion Board adjourned.
