The committee on bridge in Court Street presented the following report which on

motion was received and committee discharged.

To the Honorable Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg, Tennessee:

We, your committee appointed by the Mayor and Aldermen to have a bridge built

in place of the culvert that was washed away, we have to report to your honorable body

that we have let out the bridge to T. H. Batton for the sum of Two Hundred and Thirty

Five 00/100 Dollars (\$235.00) which contract has been complied with by said Batton and

received by your committee as satisfactory, we therefore, would recommend that a warrant

be issued by your Honorable body to said Batton for building of bridge, allof which is

respectfully submitted, September 7<sup>th</sup>, 1875.
