

**BOARD MEETING
September 1, 1875
Court House**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this Tuesday evening the 7th day of September 1875.

Present Mayor Sugg, Aldermen Smither, Stevens, Pinner, Thurman, Deberry & White and Marshall Fowlkes.

The Minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion an account in favor of ____ Nolen & Co. for \$3.00 dated April 30th 1874 was allowed and ordered paid.

The committee on bridge in Court Street presented the following report which on motion was received and committee discharged.

To the Honorable Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Dyersburg, Tennessee:

We, your committee appointed by the Mayor and Aldermen to have a bridge built in place of the culvert that was washed away, we have to report to your honorable body that we have let out the bridge to T. H. Batton for the sum of Two Hundred and Thirty Five 00/100 Dollars (\$235.00) which contract has been complied with by said Batton and received by your committee as satisfactory, we therefore, would recommend that a warrant be issued by your Honorable body to said Batton for building of bridge, allof which is respectfully submitted, September 7th, 1875.
