BOARD MEETING November 5, 1877 Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this the 5th day November 1877.

Present Mayor Clarke, Aldermen Thurmond, Scott, Pinner, White and Marshal Ferguson.

The minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.

The committee appointed to inspect the rear of the W. P. Sugg store house for the purpose of having the lot drained if found necessary, reported verbally that in their opinion it should be drained when on motion it was ordered that the report be received and committee discharged, and Alderman Pinner appointed to have the lot properly drained.

On motion an account in favor of Jno. M. McGinnis for extra work on warehouse bridge and culvert for \$16.50 was allowed and ordered paid.

On motion the following accounts were allowed:

One in favor of W. H. Simpson for \$4.05

One in favor of W. T. Chamblin & Co. for \$3.00

One in favor of Geo. W. Lavender for \$8.00

One in favor of a petition from a few citizens was presented and read to the Board praying that a Board of Health be appointed for the Town of Dyersburg when on motion of Alderman Thurmond it was ordered that the petition be laid on the table.

On motion it was ordered that the alley on the west of W. Coker be opened at once.

On motion it was ordered that the alley between E. G. Sugg and Jno. Sawyers be opened.

On motion Board adjourned.
