BOARD MEETING August 5, 1878 Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met at Court House in regular meeting this Monday evening the 5th day August 1878.

Present Mayor Clark, Aldermen Sawyers, Nichols, Scott, Parr, Miller & White and Marshal Ferguson.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

The committee on plank walk in Troy Street made a verbal report to the effect that a plank walk in said street was very much needed and they respectfully recommend that it should be built. On motion the above report was ordered to be received and committee discharged.

On motion a committee of three was ordered to be appointed to make a settlement with the Marshal up to 1st July 1878 for the purpose of ascertaining the amount of assets and liabilities of this Corporation. On motion Aldermen Parr, Miller & White were appointed a committee for same to report at next regular meeting.

On motion it was ordered that the taxes on real and personal property for the year 1878 be and is hereby assessed at Fifty cents (.50) on the One Hundred dollars.

On motion an account in favor of G. W. Lavender for \$2.50 for work on streets account was allowed.

On motion Board adjourned.
