BOARD METING September 2, 1878 Court House

On motion it was ordered that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (as a committee) meet at Grants Saloon at a time hereafter to be appointed for the purpose of examining and deciding whether they will permit said Grant to build a cistern in front of his saloon or not.
