BOARD MEETING December 9, 1878 Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met at the Court House this Monday evening the 9th day of December 1878 pursuant to adjournment.

Present Mayor Clark, Aldermen Miller, Sawyer, Scott, Parr and White.

The minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion it was ordered that G. W. Lavender be allowed the sum of Fifty 00/100 Dollars for services rendered as Marshal during our quarantine.

On motion it was ordered that the sum of Seven 80/100 be allowed to J. W. Hassel for services as Marshal and for collecting money to pay pickets.

On motion it was ordered that the Board of Mayor and Aldermen act as a committee to investigate the privies around the square and to adopt a plan for cleansing them, and keeping them so.

On motion it was ordered that the Marshal notify I. F. Child to move his fence out of the street.

On motion Board adjourned.
