

**BOARD MEETING**  
**March 7, 1881**  
**Court House**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this Monday evening the 7<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1881.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen J. M. Nichols, C. L. Nolen, E. Smith, N. C. White and J. M. Nichols Marshal.

The minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.

Alderman Smith reported that he had as one of the warehouse bridge committee seen Mr. McGinnis in regard to said bridge and that said McGinnis refused to keep the bridge in repair, whereupon on motion a committee of three were appointed to look after the said bridge and have it properly repaired. Aldermen Stevens, Nichols and Smith were appointed a committee for the same.

On motion an account in favor of T. W. Neal for printing health ordinances was allowed, amt. \$6.50.

On motion an account in favor of Wm. Stephen for hauling for Corporation was allowed, amt. \$3.00.

On motion an account in favor of Bill Blackburn for rebuilding horse racks was allowed, \$11.00.

On motion an account in favor of J. S. Peters for building plank walk to cemetery per his contract \$30.00 allowed.

On motion an account in favor of Wm. Turner for building dog-trot walk in street leading to Mrs. McCallisters was allowed, amt. \$10.00.

On motion an account in favor of Turner & Hagood for building branch walk to academy was allowed, amt. \$7.50.

On motion an account in favor of Ed Smith for amt. paid out by him was allowed, amt. \$1.60.

On motion it was ordered that Al Smith be appointed to have railing put up along the walk in Courtland Street wherever necessary.

On motion it was ordered that Henry Nichols be and is hereby appointed extra police for the Town of Dyersburg, Tennessee for the year 1881.

On motion it was ordered that F. G. Sampson, Esqr. be and is hereby appointed Mayor Pro-tem to act during the temporary absence of the present Mayor for 1881.

On motion the Board adjourned until next regular meeting.
