BOARD MEETING April 4, 1881 Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg, Tennessee met in regular meeting at the Court House this Monday evening the 4th day of April 1881.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen Stevens, Smith, Nichols, Parks, Nolen and White.

The minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.

The committee on warehouse bridge made verbal report to the effect that they had examined said bridge and that they believed it could be repaired so as to do good service for sometime yet.

Whereupon on motion it was ordered that the present committee be continued and are instructed to have said bridge properly repaired and to receive bids on same.

The committee on plank walks not being ready to report asked for further time which was granted.

On motion it was ordered that the sum of Five Hundred 00/100 Dollars (\$500.00) be allowed in part payment on A. M. Stevens bill for lumber furnished by him for plank walks and that warrants be issued for the same.

Alderman Smith reported that he had railing constructed along the plank walk in Courtland Street as far as the lumber on hand would go.

When on motion it was ordered that Alderman Smith be continued and instructed to have the railing continued as far on said walk as was necessary.

On motion it was ordered that Mayor B. L. Thomas be and is hereby appointed health officer for the Town of Dyersburg for the year 1881, and that he be allowed a fair numeration for his services.

On motion the following account was allowed in favor of Joseph Petre for constructing 800 ft plank walk & nails, \$16.80.

On motion Board adjourned.
