The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met at the Recorder's

office April 16, 1881 on call of the Mayor.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen Smith, Nichols, Parks, Nolen, Stevens and

White.

The Mayor stated the object of the meeting to be for the purpose of assessing the

privilege tax for the year 1881.

Whereupon Alderman Nichols made a motion that the privilege tax be assessed the

same for the year 1881 that it was for the year 1880.

Alderman Nolen then offered the following amendment to except saloons and

instead of the former tax on same that it be raised to One hundred dollars per year; the

vote was then taken and amendment carried.

Alderman Nichols then offered an amendment to instruct the recorder to issue all

privilege license so that they shall expire on the 1st day of November 1881 at the same rate

of last year which was by vote also carried.

When on motion of Alderman Parks the whole law as amended was adopted and so

ordered by this Board.

On motion a committee was appointed to confer with Mr. Pate Watkins and others

in regard to improving their back alley, committee Aldermen Parks, Nichols and White.

On motion Board adjourned.
