

**BOARD MEETING  
January 4, 1882  
Court House**

**The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met at the Court House this Wednesday evening the 4<sup>th</sup> day of January 1882 on call of the Mayor.**

**Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen Parks, Smith, Nolen, Stevens, Nichols and White and Marshal Nichols.**

**The Mayor explained that the Board was called together on a petition from some of the citizens of the Town to reconsider their action on last Monday night in regard to leasing the Corporation Commons to A. M. Stevens.**

**A motion was made that all the citizens present be invited to take part in this meeting, said motion was carried.**

**After considerable discussion of the question by members of the Board and citizens present a motion was made to take a standing vote of the house, for or against the ratification of the action of the Board, the vote being taken resulted in favor of ratification.**
