

**BOARD MEETING**  
**January 16, 1882**  
**Court House**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of Town of Dyersburg met at Court House this Monday evening the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January 1882 pursuant to adjournment.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen DeBerry, Stevens, Smith, Nichols and Jones.

On motion election being held to which resulted in election of W. R. Hayes Alderman for year 1882 instead of C. P. Clark

On motion W. R. Hayes was elected Recorder and Treasurer unanimously for year 1882.

On motion a committee, to wit: Jno Nichols was appointed to turn over books and papers to W. R. Hayes.

On motion finance committee was allowed until first Monday night in February to make report on motion. Account in favor of R. A. Burk for thirty three and 35/100 dollars allowed (33.35). On motion a committee was appointed to have crossings put down around town and take specifications and see that the work comes up to contract. Said committee Aldermen Stevens, Jno. Nichols, Ed Smith. On motion committee on crossings in connection with the Marshal was appointed to see that the property owners around the square repair the pavements in front of their property.

On motion Ed Smith was elected Mayor Pro-Tem in absence of Mayor Thomas for 1882.

On motion Dock Polek was elected assistant Marshall for year 1882.

On motion Board adjourned to meet again 1<sup>st</sup> Monday night in February 1882.
