

BOARD MEETING
March 6, 1882
Court House

Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Town of Dyersburg met at Court House this sixth day of March 1882.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen W. E. DeBerry, A. M. Stevens, Jno. M. Nichols, Ed Smith, A. B. Jones, W. R. Hayes and Asst. Marshall Potete.

Report of committee on walk running to Methodist Church was discharged.

On motion Board decided not to build said walk on motion of Jno. M. Nichols. Board reduced Privilege Tax on Saloons to Forty Five Dollars per annum from this date. On motion Dr. Tucker was allowed privilege of building fixture in front of Hotel provided he did not obstruct street in any way. On motion report of committee on crossings read and committee discharged.

On motion following accounts allowed:

On motion account in favor W. B. Tarrant referred to following, Jno. M. Nichols and A. B. Jones.

On motion Bond of J. W. Nichols Marshall was approved and ordered spread on minutes as follows:

“Know all men by these presents that we J. W. Nichols principal and Jno. W. Nichols security are held and jointly bound unto the Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg, Tennessee on the plural sum of Twenty Five hundred Dollars for the payment of which we bind ourselves, our heirs, representatives and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents, but the condition of the above bond is such that coharras the above bond. J. W. Nichols has been elected Marshal of the Town of Dyersburg for the year 1882. Now, therefore should the said J. W. Nichols faithfully discharge said duties, faithfully collect and account for all moneys that should come into his hands then this bond shall be null and void otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
