On motion committee on walk from Grist Mill to Webbs committee allowed further time. Committee on walk running to Col. W. E. Church reported walk finished and discharged.

On motion it was declared to be the sense of this Board that shooting galleries must be put in the rear of building.

On motion Marshall was instructed to enforce the ordinance and collect tax from wagons and water carts needing a business of running in the Corporation.

On motion ordinance in regard to opening barber shops on Sunday stands as before, not allowed to open.

On motion account in favor of R. N. Butterworth \$14.50 allowed.

On motion account in favor of S. D. Mitchell \$6.00 allowed and he to have credit for that week on his indebtedness to Corporation.

On motion account in favor of Sam? .50 allowed.

On motion Dr. Vernon and Fowlkes allowed eleven dollars for services in Small Pox case and dressing wound.

On motion account of Dr. McGaughey and Vernon and Fowlkes for vaccinating paupers laid on tables.

On motion following committee was appointed to settle with W. R. Tarraus for jail fees. Jno. W. Nichols, A. B. Jones, W. R. Hayes
