On motion account in favor Jno. McGinnis putting up lamp posts \$16.00 allowed.

An account in favor Brown Mills & Co. for coal oil allowed.

On motion account in favor W. T. Chamblin and Co. hauling \$13.10 allowed.

On motion account in favor Jackson & Nichols lamps nails \$46.35 allowed.

On motion account in favor Jno. ? work on ? \$2.55 allowed.

On motion account in favor B. L. Thomas official printing \$10.00 allowed.

On motion account for \$15.25 in favor Mayor Thomas for expense of Paducah Excursion committee allowed.

On motion E.W. Smith and W. R. Hayes were appointed committee to report on the law in regard to tax privilege of wagons water carts account – that run in the Corporation for pay.

On motion ordinance was passed taxing all persons that retail fresh meat in the Corporation in less quantities than one quarter, ten dollars privilege.

On motion Board adjourned to meet 1st Tuesday night in July.
