**On motion account in favor E. G. Sugg \$1.00 allowed.**

**On motion M. Goldsmith was ordered to tear down the house adjoining his store on the south, it being in the street.**

**On motion Marshall Nichols was instructed to have trough made for public well in front of Tuckers Hote.**

**On motion parkers in the square must be required to keep all paper rubbish clean in the street in front of their houses. On motion committee to wit: Jno Nichols, Ed Smith was appointed to settle with Recorder and Marshall to ascertain if there be funs enough in sight to repair street owing to the depot.**
