

Following members of new Board being present and Marshal Elect for the Town of Dyersburg, Tennessee to serve for the year 1883 met at the Court House on Tuesday evening on the 9th day of January 1883 and presented the following certificate of election to H. P. Doyle, J.P. of Dyer County, to wit:

The Mayor, Aldermen and Marshall elect being present, except Ed. W. Smith, were duly sworn by said H. P. Doyle, Justice of the Peace of Dyer County.

Mayor Thomas called the Board to order and on motion W. R. Hayes was by acclamation duly elected Recorder and Treasurer for Town of Dyersburg for year 1883.

On motion bond of Recorder and Treasurer and Marshall was fixed at twenty five hundred dollars each.

On motion Ed Smith was elected Mayor Pro Tem for year 1883.

On motion B. F. Parker was elected Deputy Marshal for year 1883.

On motion Marshal J. P. Thurmond was instructed to have 200 to 500 copies of the Town Ordinance printed.

On motion adjourned to meet Tuesday night January 16, 1883 – following is a recapitulation of financial standing of the Corporation:
