J. P. Thurmond, jail fee \$10.60

Hughes & Dobson, cha. Key, \$3.50

On motion petition of Mr. Goldsmith was layed on table.

On motion inspection of beef was ordered to be made either before or after the beef was killed by Marshal or Deputy.

On motion J. C. Pinner and Ed Smith was appointed to make settlement of claims of Drs. McGaughey, Ferguson and Watkins.

On motion tax receipt was ordered issued to T. J. King & Son for Twenty Five Dollars for pavement.

On motion all bonds for Corporation officers were required to be taken by the Mayor except when Mayor's office was closed, when the Marshal is instructed to take them and report to Mayor.

On motion Mayor was allowed same fee on suits that Magistrates are allowed by the State.

On motion B. L. Thomas and Ed Smith and A. B. Jones were appointed to have bulkhead built below Pinces warehouse if practicable and necessary.

On motion Board adjourned.
