On motion it was ordered that in all cases when a party is fined and offers security that the security shall be taken before the Mayor and sign the docket as security and if the Marshal fails to carry out this ordinance and the fine is not collected, the Marshal shall be charged with the same.

On motion J. C. Pinner, J. W. Baker and B. L. Thomas were appointed to have survey made and to ascertain the probable cost of having the R. R. levy ? ? for switch.
