On motion report of committee repairing walks was read and committee discharged – they having reported work done according to instructions.

On motion finance committee Z. G. Watkins and Ed Smith was appointed to settle with Recorder and Treasurer Hayes for year 1885 and Ed Smith, Z. G. Watkins, W. R. Hayes were appointed to settle with Marshal J. P. Thurmond for year 1885.
