On motion a committee – to-wit: Turner, Sinclair and Brackie were appointed to have a walk put down on street from Soyks corner to Wadlingtons residence, if in the judgment of the committee this walk aught to be put down.

On motion Ed Smith was appointed to see if arrangement could be made with Henry Cowles for opening street from St. John to Sampson Street.
