

**BOARD MEETING**  
**February 2, 1875**  
**Court House**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this Tuesday evening February 2, 1875.

Present Mayor Sugg, Aldermen Stevens, Turner, Deberry, Pinner & White and Marshall Fowlkes.

The minutes of last meeting was read, approved and signed.

An account in favor of Charles P. Moss, Esq. for \$51.50 for services rendered in suit of Webb & Child and I.F. Child against Corporation was presented, when on motion it was ordered that he be allowed \$25.00 for said services.

The following accounts one in favor of J. W. Jones and one in favor A. B. Tigrett for work done on streets was presented when on motion they were referred to the finance committee.

The Mayor appointed Aldermen Pinner & Turner finance committee for the year 1875.

On motion the Marshall was ordered to complete the open box in ditch in McGaughy Street, leading to main culvert and to take charge of streets, generally.

On motion it was ordered that Alderman Pinner shall act as Mayor Protem during the absence of the Mayor.

On motion Board adjourned.
