

**BOARD MEETING**  
**December 7, 1875**  
**Court House**

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular meeting at the Court House this Tuesday evening the 7<sup>th</sup> day December 1875.

Present Mayor Sugg, Aldermen Thurman, Pinner, Deberry, Stevens & White and Marshall Fowlkes.

The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion an account in favor of Mr. S. Hurt for \$10.25 for hauling brush and dirt on streets was allowed and ordered paid.

On motion an account in favor of Memphis Sugg & Co. for \$6.98 it being for amounts paid by them for work on streets, was allowed and ordered paid.

On motion an account in favor of Memphis J. E. Roberts & Son for \$2.20 it being for nails purchased of them in 1874 by Jno. Martin to repair plank walk, was allowed and ordered paid.

On motion the recorder was ordered to examine the law in regard to privilege tax on saloons and collect accordingly.

On motion the following allowance was made to the officers (and ordered paid) for 1875 to E. G. Sugg Mayor the sum of One Hundred 00/100 Dollars, N. C. White Recorder & Treasurer the sum of One Hundred Fifty 00/100 Dollars, J. H. Fowlkes, Marshall & street commissioner the sum of Two Hundred 00/100 Dollars.

On motion it was ordered that the following named Aldermen Deberry, Stevens, Thurman & Pinner be paid the sum of Twenty Five 00/100 Dollars each for services as Aldermen for the year 1875 and Alderman Turner & Smither to be paid the same in proportion to the time served by each.

On motion Aldermen Pinner and Smither were appointed a committee by the Mayor to settle with the Recorder & Treasurer and Marshall.

On motion Board adjourned.
