

BOARD MEETING
October 9, 1877
Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met at Court House this the 9th October 1877 (P.M.) on call of the Mayor.

Present Mayor Clarke, Aldermen Pinner, Smither, Miller, Scott & White and Marshal Ferguson.

The minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion a committee of two were appointed to inspect the rear of the W. P. Sugg store house for the purpose of having the water drained from said lot should it be necessary, Aldermen Smither & White committee.

On motion it was ordered that Meprs Parr, Nolen & Co. be allowed the privilege of constructing hay or stock scales in the rear of their store house, providing however, that they do not obstruct the alley in the rear of their store in any way whatsoever.

On motion it was ordered that A. M. Stevens be allowed the privilege to build a cooper shop on the Corporation ground near his mill he agreeing to give up the lot at any time when required.

On motion Board adjourned.
