BOARD MEETING

May 2, 1881

Court House

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Dyersburg met in regular

meeting at the Court House this Monday evening the 2nd day of May 1881.

Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen A. M. Stevens, J. M. Nichols, C. L. Nolen,

Ed Smith, H. Parks and N. C. White and H. Nichols Marshal.

The minutes of last meeting were read, approved and signed.

On motion it was ordered that Mr. J. S. Petre be allowed and paid him the amount

of one 00/100 dollar, that being a balance due him as shown by the measurement of the

Troy Street plank walk.

The committee on alley north of Pate, Parr, Nolen & Co. and others reported that

they were of the opinion that the best way to drain the back yards was to have a ditch in

said alley draining west and that the parties owning lots requiring drainage be required to

have suitable gutters to drain the water from their buildings to said ditch.

On motion the above report was received and committee discharged.

On motion it was ordered that the parties interested be and are hereby granted the

privilege of cutting a suitable ditch in the alley above referred to running west from Parr,

Nolen & Co. corner.

The committee on plank walks, on motion was given further given to make their

report.

The committee on warehouse bridge reported that they had let the contract for

repairing same to Memphis Turner & Petres and that the work had been done, the report

was received and committee discharged.

On motion it was ordered that the physicians of Dyersburg be and are hereby

required to make monthly reports to the secretary of the Board of Health, of the births,

deaths that may occur in their practice, (in accordance with the state law) in the Corporate

limits.

A motion was made to tax butchers twenty dollars for butchering in the

Corporation when it was moved that the above mention be tabled, the latter motion

prevailed and was so ordered.

On motion an account in favor of Memphis Turner & Petres for repairing

warehouse bridge amt. \$30.00 was allowed.

On motion an account in favor of S. M & H. S. Jackson for rails account \$34.85 was

allowed, on motion an account in favor of H. Nichols Asst. Mayor for amt. \$85.00 was

allowed, on motion an account in favor of Nat Tarrant Sheriff for jail fees \$2.80 was

allowed.

On motion Board adjourned.
