Minutes of last meeting read and signed.

On motion report of committee on advisability of cutting culvert north of D.

Pinner's residence read and discharged and D. Pinner was allowed privileges of making

culvert at his own expense.

Committee on pavements reported pavements completed on north and west side of

square, contract to Harton & Jones price \$83.00. Brick bought of Mac Harton \$8.00 per

1,000.

On motion committee was appointed to wit: Ed Smith, Jno. Nichols and B. L.

Thomas to examine street leading to depot and if necessary to have any work that might be

needed.

On motion account of Jno. ? 15.00 allowed.

On motion account Jno. M. Nichols brick \$5.80 allowed.

On motion account Summers & Nichols \$13.00 allowed.

On motion resignation of Jno. M. Nichols as Alderman was received and M. M.

Marshall elected to fill the unexpired term of Alderman Nichols resigned.

On motion Marshall Nichols was instructed to notify all parties that hogs running at

large on streets of Dyersburg will be taken after 30 days from this date.

Old pavement brick was sold and brought to Corporation \$43.50.

On motion following committee, Ed Smith, W. E. DeBerry, W. R. Hayes and Mayor

Thomas was appointed to investigate the matter and report what amount as Corporation

privileges aught be charged for an Auction House and if advisable in this judgment to have

the license issued to parties wanting same.

On motion meeting adjourned to meet again 1st Tuesday in November.
