On motion communication from state safety Board of Health was referred to B. L. Thomas, Chair – Dyersburg Board of Health.

On motion finance committee was appointed to settle with Recorder & Treasurer and marshal for year 1884, to-wit: Z. G. Watkins and Ed Smith were appointed to settle with W. R. Hayes, Recorder and Treasurer and Z. G. Watkins, Ed Smith and W. R. Hayes to settle with Marshal J. P. Thurmond.

On motion it was ordered that the city tax collector shall be governed by same laws that apply to county trustee in the collection of Corporation taxes and on the first day of November of each year Corporation taxes still uncollected shall be placed in hands of an officer of collection.

On motion Ed Smith was appointed to have ? run on east side of street in front of M. M. Marshall's residence if found necessary on examination.

On motion a committee Ed Smith, A. B. Jones and B. L. Thomas was appointed to examine and report what aught to be done with the bridge east of Sugg's Hotel.

On motion Board adjourned to meet again on last Monday night in December it being the 29th day of said month for the transaction of any business that may be brought before the Board.
