A. Local Government Committee meeting minutes – November 29, 2021 – Chairwoman Mary Claire Hopper

B. Resolution 12062021 – Acceptance of initial distribution of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds

The ARPA funds were initially discussed at the meeting with Mayor Holden stating the City received half of their funding \$2,420,291.71 two weeks prior with the second half to be received between March and October 2022. City Recorder Scott Ball, in the committee meeting, noted the funding could only be used for certain items such as infrastructure, premium pay, and premium quality-of-life projects.

Upon the conclusion of the reading of the minutes, Alderman James Baltimore motioned to approve the resolution, which noted the City has established a separate account for the funds for the receipt and expenditure in the amount of \$4,840,583.42. The motion was seconded by Alderman Ricky Hammond and passed unanimously.
