

BOARD MINUTES
Tuesday, January 2, 1872
Court House

“I, A. B. Tigrett Sheriff of Dyer County, do certify that at an election held at the Court House in Dyersburg on the 30th day of December 1871, for seven Aldermen for said Town for the year 1872, C.P. Clark, G.B. Miller, J.E. Roberts, F.G. Sampson, W.E. Deberry and J.C. Pinner were elected and John W. Wilson and C.L. Nolen the two next highest received fifty votes each – January 2, 1872, A.B. Tigrett, Sheriff”.

The above certificate of election was presented to Geo. B. Tinsley Esquire, an acting Justice of the Peace in and for Dyer County at the Court House in Dyersburg on Tuesday evening January 2, 1872, and C.P. Clark, G. B. Miller, J.E. Roberts, F.G. Sampson, W.E. Deberry and J.C. Pinner were duly sworn by said Justice faithfully to discharge the duties required of them as Aldermen.

J.W. Wilson and C.L. Nolen having both declined, G.D. McAllister was by the Board duly elected an Alderman for the year 1872 to fill the vacancy, and he was duly sworn by Geo. B. Tinsley, J.P.

Charles P. Clark was duly elected Mayor and sworn. F. G. Sampson was duly elected Recorder and Treasurer, John W. Nichols was duly elected Marshal and sworn.

On motion it was ordered that hereafter all fines shall be controlled only by the Mayor’s discretion.

On motion the regular meetings of this Board are ordered to be held on the 2nd Tuesday night in each month.

On motion it is ordered that all the Regulations remain in force as at present until further notice.

On motion the Board adjourned to meet at the Court House next Tuesday morning.
