

**BOARD MEETING**  
**February 24, 1882**  
**Court House**

**At a call meeting of Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Town of Dyersburg met at Court House February 24, 1882.**

**Present Mayor B. L. Thomas, Aldermen Stevens, W. E. DeBerry, Jno. Nichols, A. B. Jones and W. R. Hayes and Marshall Nichols.**

**Object of meeting was explained by Mayor to be for the purpose of making some arrangements for taking care of small pox cases that have or may occur in our Town.**

**On motion a committee of chairmen and one physician was appointed to have a Pest House built, to wit: Jno. M. Nichols, A. B. Jones, W. E. DeBerry, and Mayor Thomas was added to committee. On motion Board endorsed what the Mayor had done in regard to taking care and quarantining those exposed to the Small Pox.**

**On motion all parties who have been exposed to Small Pox must be quarantined.**

**On motion the Captain and ? of all boats are required to report all cases that may be complaining when they land at the wharf at Dyersburg to Mayor Thomas.**

**On motion Board adjourned.**
