On motion committee on bulk head was allowed further time to report.

On motion committee to settle with E. C. Pate allowed further time.

On motions following accounts allowed:

Jackson & Nichols – Eight & 90/100 dollars

On motion Recorder was instructed to communicate with S. P. Hill in regard to R. suite against Corporation.
