

**BOARD MEETING  
March 2, 1885  
Court House**

**Board of Mayor and Aldermen for Town of Dyersburg met at the Court House on Monday night March 2, 1885.**

**Present Aldermen Ed Smith, A. B. Jones, Wm. Turner, J. W. Tenney and W. R. Hayes and Marshal J. P. Thurmond.**

**Alderman J. W. Tenney was called to the chair.**

**Minutes of last meeting read and approved.**

**Committee reported that walk east of Sugg's Hotel was in bad condition and Marshal Thurmond was instructed to immediately have same repaired.**

**On motion committee on walk running to Dr. Arnold's alley was allowed further time.**

**On motion following accounts were allowed:**

<b>779 - ? lumber cemetery</b>	<b>\$100.97</b>

**On motion it was declared a nuisance for dogs to run at large on the streets of Dyersburg and after five days notice the Town Marshall was instructed to kill all dogs found running at large on street not muzzled.**

**On motion Marshal was ordered to have sewer run from King's corner to the old Jordan driving stable.**
