## MINUTES OF THE MEETING BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN March 7, 2005

## PUBLIC HEARING: CDBG – HOUSING REHAB POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Recorder Gleyn Twilla explained that the proposed Policies and Procedures for the CDBG Housing Rehab Grant for Broadway Avenue were pre-approved by HUD and Tennessee Economic and Community Development. The project will be administered in compliance with the proposed policies and procedures. A total of \$500,000 will be spent on Broadway Avenue to bring owner occupied housing up to standard.

The CDBG Housing Rehab policies and procedures were approved on a motion by Aldermen Guthrie and Dean.

## MISC.

<u>Alderman Guthrie</u> asked city staff to help stop 4-wheel traffic on park grounds and at the retention behind Ingram Field on Lake Road.

<u>Alderman Guthrie and Dudley</u> commended the Dyersburg High School boys and girls basketball teams and urged everyone to attend the girl's game at the state tournament.

<u>Alderman Dean</u> asked charities to be more prompt in removing advertising banners from the Lake Road/Bypass intersection after their events.

<u>Alderman Lee</u> requested police to check the high rate of speed of big trucks on Lake Road north of the Bypass.

<u>Alderman Moody</u> recommended that the Municipal Building be named in honor of Police Chief Bobby Williamson for 48 years of service to the City including 35 years as Chief.
