Site Plan Process

The site plan review process is established by the Dyersburg Zoning Ordinance Article XXIII Section O. A site plan is required for all mutli-family residential uses of four (4) dwelling units or more, for all buildings and structures in the B-1, B-2, P-B, HM, M-1, M-2 and M-3 zones and for all buildings or structures which are to house a Use Permitted on Appeal in every zone.

- 1. Contact City Planner. Determine if formal site plan is required. In some minor cases owner drawn site plans are allowed.
- 2. Contact survey or engineer to do site plan. They will contact City Planner and City Engineer.
- 3. Preparation of site plan.
- 4. Submit site plan to City Planner two weeks prior to the Planning Commission (P.C.) meeting on second Thursday of coming month. Minimum of five copies.
- 5. Site plan evaluation. Staff review written one week prior to P.C. meeting.
- 6. Attend P.C. meetings. Approval granted with or without modifications by Commission. Denial prohibits issue of building permit.
- 7. Obtain required stormwater and building permits.
