- (1) <u>Call to Order:</u> The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session on Monday, June 15, 2015 in the Dyersburg Municipal Court Room at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Holden presided over the meeting. The meeting opened with prayer by Alderman Terry Glover. Mayor Holden noted all Aldermen were present.
- (2) <u>Approval of Minutes:</u> The minutes of the June 1, 2015 meeting were approved on a motion by Alderwoman Carolyn Norman, followed by a second from Alderman Robert Taylor Jr. The motion passed approving the minutes.

Mr. Williams recommended awarding the bid to Compass Minerals, Overland Park, KS, at \$36,000.00. A motion to approve the recommendation as presented before the Board was made by Alderman Bill Escue with a second by Alderman Dennis Moody. The motion passed by full Board approval.

d. Purchase of Property

Mayor Holden presented a purchase contract between the City of Dyersburg and B & B Partners for land and building property located at 415 Highway 51 Bypass, Dyersburg, TN. This property is adjacent to the currently owned City property housing the Public Works complex. The property has been completely inspected for any environmental concerns and there appears to be no adverse environmental issues. Mayor Holden noted the acquisition of the property would significantly enhance the productivity of the Public Works Complex. After general discussion Alderwoman Carolyn Norman motioned to approve the purchase as presented in the purchase agreement stated at \$212,500.00. The motion was seconded by Alderman Kevin Chaney. The motion passed by full board vote.

e. Chamber of Commerce – 2015/2016 Tourism and Economic Development (TED) Budget & Economic Development Update – Allen Hester & Jimmy Williamson.

Jimmy Williamson, Chairman of the Chamber's board of directors, opened the presentation expressing his excitement and enthusiasm for the work the

Chamber does on behalf of the community. Mr. Williamson noted two requests in coming before the Board: first to approve the proposed 2015-16 budget for the TED, and secondly, to approve the formal written agreement for this support by the City. Mr. Williamson introduced Allen Hester, President/CEO, who provided an update of past year accomplishments in 2015, and current endeavors for growth and industry recruitment, and promotion of tourism plans. The 2015-16 budget presented by Mr. Hester will be realized through hotel/ motel tax revenue received by the City annually.

Mayor Holden entertained a motion for approval of the 2015-16 budget. Alderman Bob Kirk moved to approve the budget, followed by a second from Alderman Dennis Moody. The motion passed by full vote.

Secondly, a motion was made by Alderman Robert Taylor, Jr. to approve the two year contract supporting the agreement between the City and the Chamber of Commerce. The motion was seconded by Mike Morgan, and passed by full Board vote.

f. Fourth of July Community Response Plane – Police Chief Steve Isbell.

Chief Steve Isbell informed the Board of the Police Department plans to provide public safety and response to activities associated with the public's celebration of the Fourth of July events in Dyersburg. Chief Isbell read the recent Department wide memo as follows:

"For the past several years we have experienced escalating violence on the Fourth of July Holiday. This reached a point last year where groups tried to separate officers with the intent to cause harm. Due to the increasing risk there will be schedule changes for the days surrounding the holiday. All officers assigned to patrol will be required to work on July 3rd, 4th, and 5th. This includes SROs and Street Crimes. You will be notified by your supervisor of the schedule at a later date along with detail assignments".
