CITY OF DYERSBURG Municipal Landfill

Location: 2 miles south of Dyersburg off of South Main, 2250 Sorrell Chapel Road

Hours: Monday thru Friday 7:00 am to 4:00 pm. Materials must be unloaded by 3:30 pm

Attention: We have separate areas for trees, yard-waste, white goods, inert waste and household waste. The attendant will direct you to the proper disposal area.

Landfill Permit Sticker:

City residents only may obtain <u>one</u> permit sticker per household with proof of residence, vehicle registration, and photo identification at the landfill office, if approved. Permit must be adhered to the windshield (in plain view) on the <u>permit holder's registered vehicle</u>.

Landfill Permit <u>will not be issued</u> for any profitable or commercial business of any type, large or small; rental property is considered a profitable business. Permit is strictly for use by the occupant/resident as recorded on permit application and acceptable material must come from no other place than the household address as recorded on the permit application.

Please note: When arriving at the landfill, you may be asked to verify your City residency with either a driver's license or current utility bill.

All customers without permit stickers will be charged accordingly.

In order to help keep our City clean from blowing litter and trash, we have a landfill cover law. All loads must be appropriately covered or enclosed to prevent any portion of the vehicle's contents from leaking, blowing, and dropping, falling or otherwise departing from the vehicle. Any vehicle in violation of the cover law will not be able to use the landfill.

All vehicles must obey posted signs. All vehicles transporting waste onto the landfill are subject to inspection by landfill personnel. When residents unload their material, we ask that <u>children remain in the vehicle for their safety.</u>

Landfill employees are not allowed to unload materials. Please do not ask them to.

Policy for Landfill Charges:

Any city resident may take <u>one load</u> of acceptable materials from his/her **home residence** to the landfill at no charge once per month as long as he/she has a <u>city sticker/permit on their registered vehicle</u>. This vehicle must be used to transport unwanted materials to the landfill. A load is considered one pickup truck bed or one 5 x 8 trailer. Anything more will be charged at Gate Price.

Any contracted worker (large or small jobs) may take acceptable materials to the landfill at Gate Price. ALL rental property is considered a "for-profit business" and "clean-outs", remodeling etc. will be charged at Gate Price.
